JACKSON PARK GOLF COURSE LOCAL RULES

USGA RULES SHALL GOVERN PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY THESE LOCAL RULES:

- **OUT OF BOUNDS.** OB is designated with white stakes and/or boundary fences.
- **EMBEDDED BALL.** Anywhere through the green, a ball is embedded in its own pitch mark, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the original spot but no nearer to the hole. No penalty.
- **TEMPORARY GREENS.** When a ball lands on a temporary or alternate green that is not in play, the ball must be lifted, dropped no nearer the hole and at least one club length off the putting surface. No Penalty.
- **ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS.** Play is prohibited from Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards that are marked "ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE". These areas are identified by GREEN TOPPED RED OR YELLOW STAKES. Do not enter environmentally sensitive areas.
- **POWER LINES AND POLES.** A ball striking a power line must be replayed. No Penalty. A ball striking a power pole, guide wire or transformer must be played where it lands.

PACE OF PLAY GUIDELINES. Slow play is a great concern for all of us. We define slow play as being more than 1 ½ shots behind the group ahead of you. While we realize that play may be slowed due to searches for lost balls, we encourage you to keep up with the group in front of you, if you do not keep pace, we may ask you to pick up your ball and regain your position, ask you to finish your round on the Executive course or cancel your round and refund your greens fees.

PLAYER CONSIDERATIONS

- Player Assistants will be on the course to guide and assist pace of play. All players must have their own set of clubs and bag.
- Early morning players please yield to the maintenance staff.
- Power carts must observe all course signage and abide by the posted cart rule in effect for that day.
- Dress code – Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times while on the golf course property.
- Alcoholic beverages not purchased at our facility are NOT permitted.
- Coolers and ice chests are not allowed at anytime.
- Please repair ball marks, rake bunkers and replace divots.
